

29-L District Governor's Monthly Activity Contest - 2011-2012

SIGHT SERVICES

1. For each eye exam provided (Date and Initials of First and Last Name of Client) (100 points/exam)
2. For each pair of eyeglasses provided (Date and Initials of Client) (100 points/glasses)
3. For each pair of used eyeglasses collected (10 points/pair)
4. Provide special equipment to assist a person with vision problems (Date and Initials of Client) (500 points once/year per client)
5. Sponsor Eye Screening or Mobile Eye Screening Unit (MESU) (500 points/location)
For each sponsoring club members working screening equipment unit (250 points/day/min. 2 hours)
For each person screened (25 points)
For each club that has individual members who operate the MESU Unit (driver/assistant) (250 points/day/min. 2 hours)
6. Project/donation to WV Sight (500 points+1 point/\$ donated+200 points/each Lion (max. 2 times per year) (Zone Project same as above except monies divided by number of participating clubs)
7. Deaf & Blind Recreation/WV School of Deaf & Blind Work Program/Guide Dog Donations (500 points+1 point/\$ donated or spent)

HEARING SERVICES

1. For each hearing aid collected (50 points)
2. Provide special equipment to assist a person with hearing problems (Date and Initials of client) (250 points ... once/year per client)

ENVIRONMENT / PROMOTION OF GREEN ENVIRONMENT

1. Adopt-A-Highway/Adopt-A-Spot/Area Cleanup (500 points+100 points/Lion/non-Lion worker (min. 2 hours, max. 4 times per year)
2. Tree Planting ... 500 points+1 point/\$ spent+100 points/Lion/non-Lion worker (min.-2 hours)
3. Community Cleanup/Manning Dumpsters (500 points+100 points/Lion/non-Lion worker) (min. 2 hrs.)

YOUTH SERVICES

1. Drug Awareness/Flag Day/International Youth Camp/Lions Quest/Partners in Education/Peace Poster/Recreation/Sport/Scholarships/Scouting/ Special Olympics/Youth Exchange (500 points+100 points/\$ spent Activity or Donation+100 Points/Lion and other workers/min. 2 hrs. (List date and description of Activity)
2. Leo Club/Lions Club Joint Activity (Date and description of activity) (500 points+1 point/\$ spent or donated+100 points/Lion/non-Lion (min. 2 hours)
3. Lions Youth Exchange Student (Hosting) (6 weeks/2,000 points) ... (3 weeks/1,000 points) ... Sponsor a local student (500 points/student)

COMMUNITY SERVICES

1. Aid to the Elderly/Crime Prevention or Safety/Homeless/Literacy/Recreation/Hosting an event to honor community groups* (500 points+1 point/\$ spent or donated+100 points/Lions/non-Lion workers/min. 2 hrs.) *If donations are received, must be deducted from monies spent.
2. Ongoing Projects (250 points/1st month ... 100 points/additional Month (maximum ongoing projects 3 per month) (recycling ink cartridges, can only claim twice per year)
3. Donations to Local Community Projects and Organizations (500 points+1 point/\$ spent or donated) (max. 2 per year)
4. Assisting another organization with a community project (500 points+100 points/Lion (min. 3 Lions) (min. 2 hours) (Describe activity/names of Lions/non-Lion participants each time)

DIABETES AWARENESS AND EDUCATION

1. Camp Kno-Koma/Diabetes Screening/Education/Health Fair/Other/Provide Medicine/Equipment (500 points+1 point/\$ spent)

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS/CLUB TWINNING

1. Interclub Assistance/Lions Day with the U.N./World Peace Day (500 points+1 point/\$ spent)

HEALTH SERVICES

1. Blood Donations/Health Education/Health Fair/Heart Walk, Cancer, Relay for Life (500 points+1 point/\$ spent or donated) If participating in walks (Strides Walk) or Relay for Life, list participants by name and add 100 points/Lion) (min. 2 hrs.)
2. Other (500 points+1 point/\$ spent or donated) (max. twice per year) (List date, description of activity and list of participants by name)

ATTENDANCE AT SPECIAL EVENTS

(Points to be given for EACH member. All Lions names must be listed.)

Lions International Convention, USA/CANADA Lions Leadership Forum, Multiple District 29 Convention, WV Lions Leadership School, District 29-L Conference (Must be registered and attend banquet), District 29-L Cabinet Meetings, Region Meetings/Special Events, International Headquarters (Oak Brook, IL), Leader Dog/Pilot Dog/Paws for a Cause, WVU Eye Research Center, Morgantown (500 points, list names)

4. DG's Monthly Activity Report postmarked by 20th or e-mailed by last day of current month (300 points)
5. Monthly Activity Report to International postmarked by 20th or e-mailed by last day of current month (300 points/monthly) (500 points/annual reports)
6. Scheduling District Governor's Visit before 9/1 (500 points)
7. Monthly Board of Directors' Meeting (separate from regular meeting) (100 points)
8. Copying and distributing DG Newsletter to all members (750 points)
9. Publication and distributing Club Newsletter to all members. (200 points) (Include copy)
10. Having a program at your club meetings (200 points) (List Date/Presenter)
11. Having a District Chairperson as a club program (Deaf & Blind Recreation/Work Program, Diabetes Awareness/LEHP, Information Technology, LCIF, LEO, District Leadership Chr., District Membership Chr, MESU, Public Relations/Peace Poster, Service/Guide Dogs, WV Sight, Youth Exchange) (500 points) (List date/presenter)
12. Having a Membership drive using the District Membership Chr/Leadership Chr, Team (1,000 points)
13. Sponsoring a New LEO club or Lions club (5,000 points)
14. Provide a Rebuilding Lion/Guiding Lions/Certified Guiding Lions after training (1,000 points/year)

HONORS

1. Name a Melvin Jones Fellow or a Leonard Jarrett Fellow (new/progressive), Club "Lion of the Year" (500 points)
2. Member of the WVLSCF Trust Fund/new member (200 points)

PUBLICITY

1. Article/photo describing in detail a Lions project (200 points) (enclose copy, list publisher, date)
2. Published meeting/project announcement (50 points) (enclose copy, publisher, date)
3. Article/photo featuring club project/club member in LION Magazine (200 points) (Enclose copy, date)
4. Project featured on television or radio (list date, network, station, description, etc.) (250 points)
5. Club Web Page on the internet (New page/once per year) (100 points first time)
6. Updating Club Web Page (50 points per update (Max once per month ... only when actually updated)
7. Lions outdoor Logo Sign displayed in your community. (750 points .. club) (once per year) (Send photo of sign)
8. Erecting a Lions Billboard in your community, send photo. (750 points given .. club once/year) (500 points given .. Zone .. once/year)

PUBLICITY (Continued)

9. Club Brochures distributed to community or flyer describing club projects or fund raiser, send copy (100 points)
10. Set up a Lions Awareness Display at a major community function such as: fair, car show, festival, etc. (250 points)

FUNDRAISING

1. Club Fundraiser (500 points+1 point/\$ raised+100 points/Lion/non-Lion worker (min.- 2 hrs.) (Ongoing Fundraisers - Monthly ... 100 points/month) (Includes only fundraisers netting over \$100./mo.)

VISITATION CONTEST

All regular visitations are to be listed in the "Last Visitation" section, page 3 of monthly club report forms. Only visitations achieving special points on the District Governor's Contest are to be listed on the DG Contest Form area.

1. Each Lion visiting another Lion, Lioness, or LEO Club (20 points)
2. For each visit 50 miles or more round trip, the points will be doubled. To qualify, write "50" in the corner of the visitation card.
 - . To receive credit for a visit, a signed Visitation Card must accompany the MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT and be sent to the contest chairperson.
 - . All members from the same club may list their names on the front of one card.
 - . Visitation Certificates will be awarded to Lions receiving a minimum of five (5) visitations.
